Club	Objectives	Time Frame
Phonics Club	The primary focus of phonics instruction is to help beginning readers understand how letters are linked to sounds (phonemes) to form letter-sound correspondences and spelling patterns and to help them learn how to apply this knowledge in their reading.	Semester 1 and 2
Art and Craft Club	Precision and particularity are what a child learns through craft making. It teaches them patience along with behavioral skills that involve dealing with anything in a delicate manner first instead of losing patience. Crafts explore themes such as culture, science, and math. Through these crafts, students learn background information about each of the themes.	Semester 1 and 2
Non- fire Cooking Club	Cooking teaches children the importance of being self-reliant in terms of daily sustenance. This is important because it also teaches them the importance of food in general.	Semester 1 and 2
Zumba Club	Zumba classes incorporate key childhood development elements like leadership, respect, team work, confidence, self-esteem, memory, creativity, coordination, cultural awareness.	Semester 1 and 2
